**Fishers of Men**

Last week we read about the beginning of Jeremiah's life as a prophet; this week's first reading tells the story of how Isaiah, too, became a spokesman for God. The incident relates how unworthy he felt in the presence of God, and how his sense of sinfulness was taken away by burning coals that purified him. Simon Peter, too was aware of his sinfulness when Jesus worked the miracle of the great catch of fish.

But he, too, was made worthy of being God's spokesman by the healing presence of Christ. Jesus taught from Peter's boat and it is a striking reminder of the importance of Peter both during the life of Jesus and in the formation of the early Church.
